CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

'Codes of Behaviour' are to ensure that football maintains a positive image in our community and provides a safe environment in which to learn and enjoy football.

It is imperative that players and parents have read and abide by the following Codes of Conduct.

PLAYERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play by the rules
- Never argue with an umpire or an official. If you disagree you should pursue the matter with your team manager or coach.
- Play to enjoy the game and improve your football skills.
- Control your temper and do not indulge in any verbal or physical abuse of an umpire, official or any player.
- Be a good sport and acknowledge all good efforts from your team and the opposition.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Co-operate with your coach, teammates and opponents, as, without them, there would be no game.

PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Do not force an unwilling child to participate in football.
- Ensure that your efforts to enjoy the child's involvement in sport do not detract from their enjoyment.
- Encourage the child to always play by the rules and codes of conduct.
- Focus upon the child's efforts and performances rather than the result of the game. This will assist the child to set realistic goals related to his or her ability by reducing the emphasis on winning.
- Children learn by example, applaud good plays by both teams.
- Do not publicly question umpire's judgment and never their honesty.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from junior football.
- Recognise the value and importance of the volunteer coaches. They give of their time and resources and deserve your support.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
